

Sort It Out Mini Game

How to win

The first player to reach 20 points or more wins the game.

Set Up

- Each player takes a tile holder and a set of 5 different coloured tiles (Pink, Yellow, Green, Blue and Orange).
- Shuffle the Topic cards and place into the bottom of the box. The cards should be facing topic side up and place in the centre of the table so everyone can reach the cards.
- Have a piece of paper and pencil handy to keep score.

How to Play

1. The youngest player (the Reader) goes first and picks a Topic card from the top of the desk. He / She read the question aloud to all the players and places the card topic side up in the corner of the table for everyone to view.

NOTE: Be sure not to let anyone see the answers on the back.

2. All the players now respond to the question on the Topic card by placing their 5 different coloured tiles in the order they believe is correct inside the Tile holders.
3. Once all the players have finished placing their coloured tiles into their tile holders, the Reader then flips over the Topic card and all players check their answers.

Scoring

1. If a player places all 5 tiles in the correct order, he/she gets 5 points.
2. If a player places only 1, 2 or 3 tiles in the correct order, he/she earns the same number of points as the number of tiles placed in the correct order.
3. If a player does not place any of his/her tiles in the correct order, he/she does not earn any points.
4. Play continues to the right, with the next player choosing a Topic card and reading the question aloud to the group.

Winning the Game

The first player to reach 20 points or more wins the game. If there are two or more players with the same number of points, all those players are declared the winners.
